

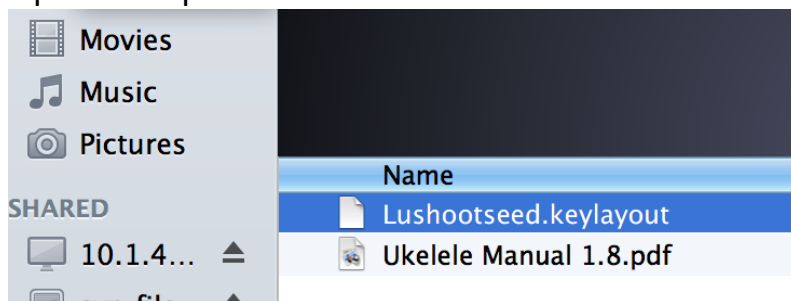
## Installing the Lushootseed Unicode Keyboard on a Mac.

Keyman also offers an online International keyboard, **keymanweb.com**, just select your Language, however some characters don't show up, and that's a limit of the mobile device and carrier.

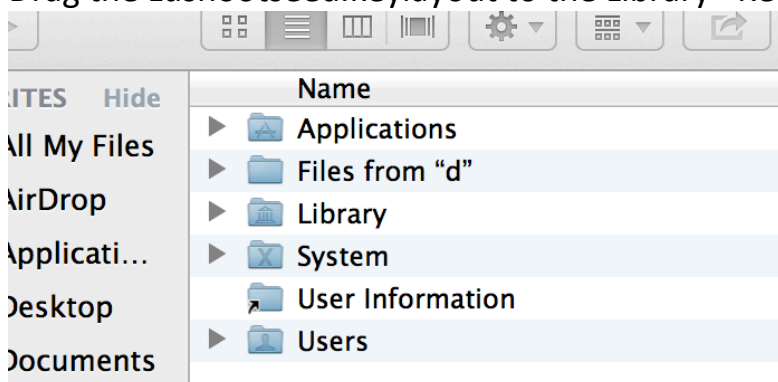
This keyboard is for use with Unicode fonts, ie. LushootseedSchool or LushootseedSulad. Download the Mac Keyboard zip file, from [www.TulalipLushootseed.com](http://www.TulalipLushootseed.com).

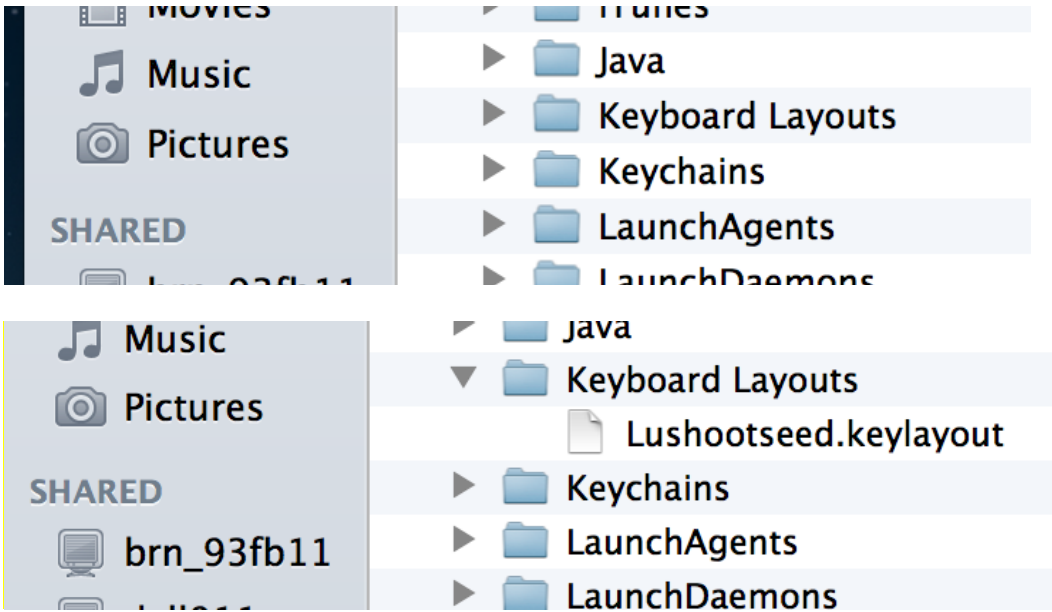


Open the zip file



Drag the Lushootseed.keylayout to the Library > Keyboard Layouts folder





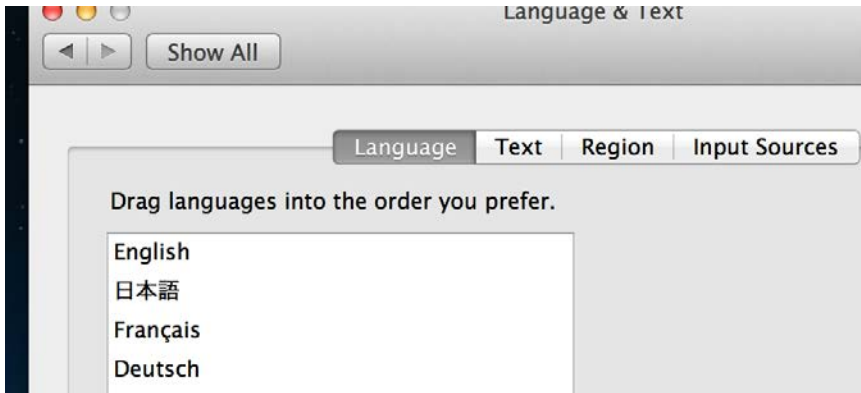
Now close those folders and go to system settings., “the gears.”



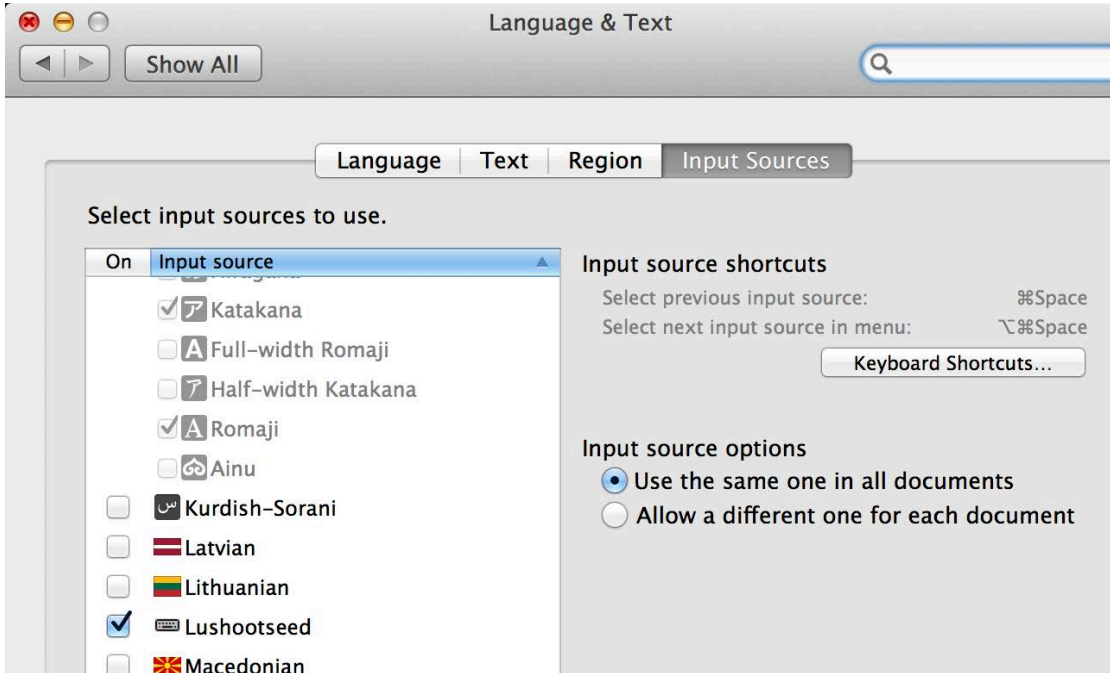
And click on Language & Text



Once there click on “Input Sources.”



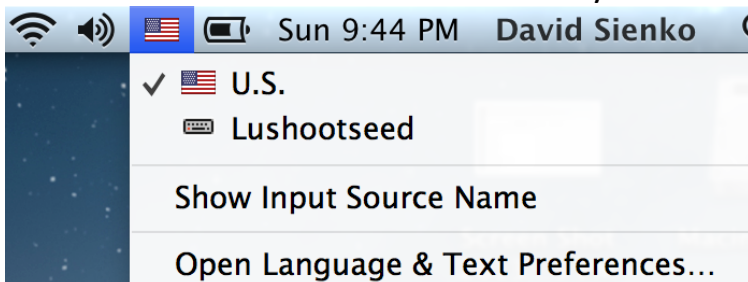
Then scroll down until you find “Lushootseed,” and check the box.



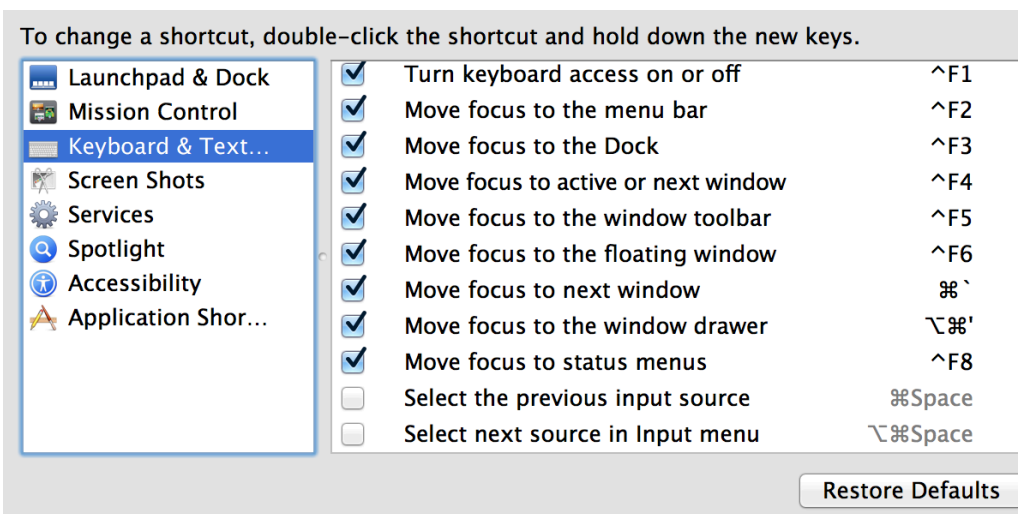
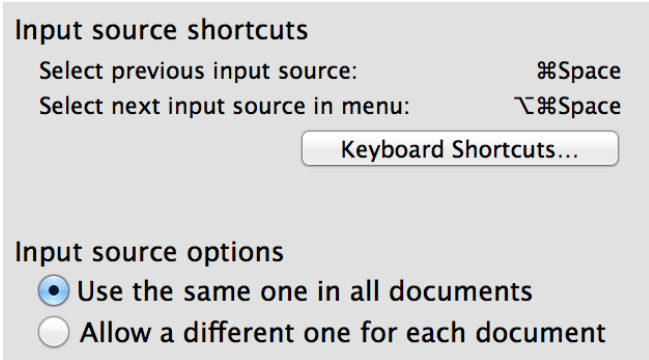
You can end there, or you can setup a hot key to switch between languages. Here’s what it looks like on the Desktop.



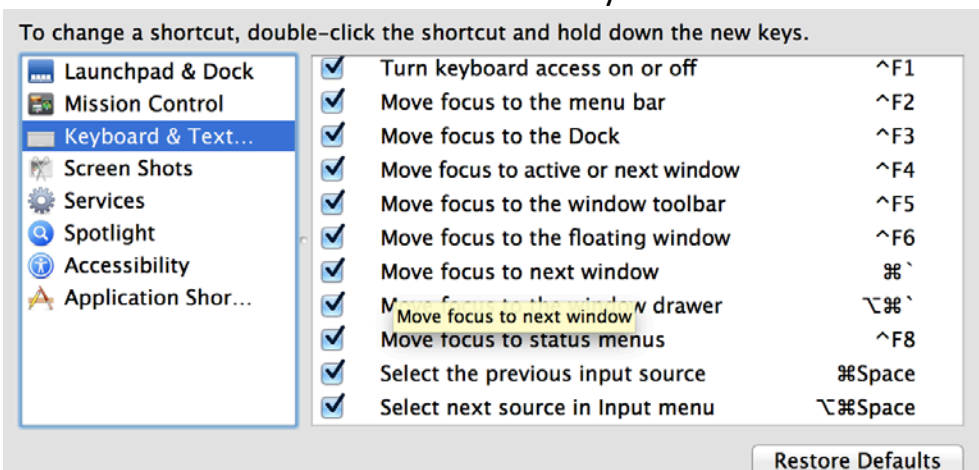
You can then click between the two keyboards with a mouse.



Or as mentioned earlier you can set up a keyboard toggle. Back when we were setting up the keyboard, an option appeared called “Keyboard Shortcuts.” When you click on that, you can then click on “Keyboard & Text”



Then check the last two boxes in the Keyboard & Text menu.



You can then apply and exit the Preferences and settings menu.

By checking those two boxes you can now toggle between English and Lushootseed by holding and pressing the Shift-Command and Space bar. You may get a warning, because that command is also used by Macs’ “Spotlight” feature. But as noted on the screen shot above it’s possible to edit a different toggle command.

**Now restart your computer** to make sure the software starts properly for the first time.
