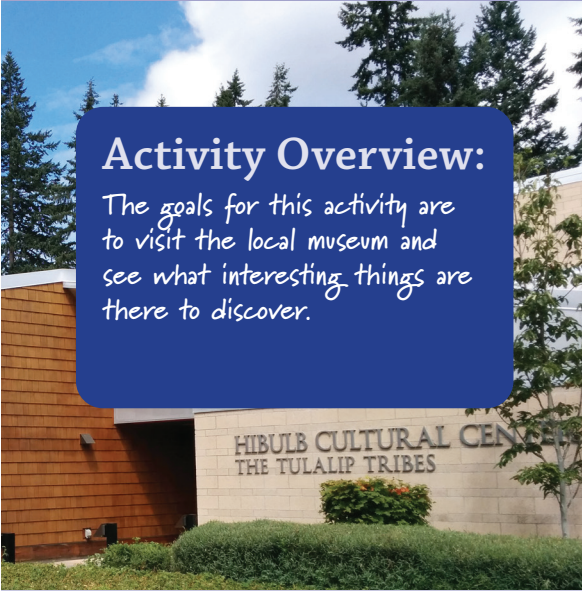
Hibulb Museum Visit

- Once you go inside, there are many exhibits to find and see, the sʔayilalʔtxʷ (museum) is a self-guided tour so ʔihišəd (families) can explore on their own.
- Make sure to dʔəlaʔadbid (visit) the ɸilʔbid (Canoe) hall, Main Gallery, pigʷədalʔtxʷ (Longhouse) hall and the ever-changing temporary exhibit hall.
- In the pigʷədalʔtxʷali (Longhouse Hall), does it look like a modern ʔalʔal (house) at all? stab kʷi ʔudiʔdiʔgʷas gʷəl stab kʷi ʔuləliʔ What would look the same and what would be different?
- Take this time to share any experience your family has had in longhouses.
