

### **Procedures/Instructions**







- Go to nearest river, creek and or ocean or visit all three.
  - » Examples: Tulalip Marina, Hermosa Beach, Kayak Point, Spee-bi-dah, Camano Head, Port of Everett (hibulb), Stillaguamish River, Snohomish River, Tulalip Hatchery, Battle Creek (žiliž d²ə⁴ixw), Quilceda Creek.
- When you are at the beach, river and or creek you can use the language phrases with your children like stab čəx<sup>w</sup> ?əsšudx<sup>w</sup> (What do you see?) ?əsšudx<sup>w</sup> čəd ti \_\_\_\_\_ (I see \_\_\_\_\_\_), čad k<sup>w</sup>i dəx<sup>w</sup>?əsfaflils (Where does this live, and ?əsfaflil ti \_\_\_\_ ?al (ti \_\_\_\_. \_\_\_ lives at \_\_\_\_.)
- You can observe the fish habitats and determine whether the salmon in the area are river or ocean salmon. Ask others how they made their decision.
