Activity Instructions



Berry Picking

- Pack appropriate materials for a long period of time in the sbabadil (mountains), such as water, snacks, buckets for picking swada?x (huckleberries), wipes/toilet paper, a blanket for sitting, and an offering (such as cedar, tobacco, or sage) for the swatixwtad (land).
- 2. The berry picking area is in the sbabadil (*mountains*), so be sure to have vehicle that is safe to travel on dirt/gravel roads with high incline. Explain to the younger children that you are traveling to <code>4ucababiluale cale (We will go out berry picking)</code>.
- 3. Say a st'iwił (*prayer*) and give an offering (such as cedar, tobacco or sage) to the swatix^wtəd (*land*) and t'ig^wid (*thank*) the swatix^wtəd (*land*) before you start ?uləxəd (*harvesting*) berries. A small prayer to the land could be: ?ut'ig^wid čəł ti swatix^wtəd dx^w?al ti swəda?x.
- Sing cababilut st'ilib (berry picking song) while picking the berries. This time would be great incorporate Lushootseed:
 - · łuċəbəbiluł čəł We will go out berry picking.
 - ?əfəd čəx^w ?u ti swada?x Do you eat huckleberries?
 - ?əsxax txw cəxw ?u Do you like it?
 - ha?4 ?u *Is it good?*
 - ?əs?əxidalus What color is it?
- 5. Take breaks for water and food as needed.
- 6. After harvesting, thank the land again (t'igwicid swatixwtəd) and take berries home to wash and store for later use.
