

EXPECTATIONS OF GROUP LEADERS

1. GROUP LEADERS WILL ATTEND EACH FULL DAY OF CAMP, FROM 10 A.M. TO 3:15 P.M.
2. GROUP LEADERS WILL KNOW WHERE ALL OF THEIR CHILDREN ARE AT ALL TIMES.
3. GROUP LEADERS WILL PARTICIPATE IN ALL ACTIVITIES WITH THE CHILDREN, INCLUDING SPEAKING AS MUCH LUSHOOTSEED AS POSSIBLE (WITH GUIDANCE FROM STAFF).
4. GROUP LEADERS ARE EXPECTED TO CONTROL THE CHILDREN'S BEHAVIOR DURING INDIVIDUAL SESSIONS. (IT IS NOT UP TO THE PRESENTER TO CORRECT THE CHILDREN.)
5. GROUP LEADERS WILL TREAT ALL THE CHILDREN WITH RESPECT. THEY WILL NOT SCREAM AT OR BELITTLE THE CHILDREN. THEY WILL USE POSITIVE STEPS TO CORRECT CHILDREN'S BEHAVIORS.
6. GROUP LEADERS ARE EXPECTED TO EAT LUNCH WITH THE CHILDREN AND CONTROL THEIR GROUP DURING THE LUNCH PERIOD.
7. IF A CHILD IS NOT LISTENING OR YOU CANNOT COPE WITH THEIR BEHAVIOR, BRING THEM MICHELE OR TOSHA. MICHELE OR TOSHA WILL TALK WITH THEM AND CALL THEIR PARENTS IF NECESSARY.

We thank you for considering being a volunteer for the annual Lushootseed Language Camp. We hope that you will enjoy the camp, and volunteer once again in the future years this camp is put on.

Volunteers:

Camp is put on two separate weeks in the summer each year. If you have not volunteered before, or attended Language Camp as a child, we ask that you attend and participate in the activities so that you have a good idea what camp is like before you volunteer. Our volunteers work mainly as group leaders.

The role of a group leader is:

- to attend camp each day for a full week**
- to be in charge of a group of 10+ children**
- to participate in all activities with your group members including use of Lushootseed**
- be sure that your group members are behaving as well as they can throughout the day**
- stay with your group at all times from 10 am until 3:15 pm**
- attend the lunch with your assigned group; make sure each child is with you before you leave the eating area**

On the first day of camp each week, we ask that the volunteers arrive at camp at 9:30 am (half an hour early) for orientation. At this time you will find out what group you are in charge of, and review camp rules and activities. The other four days of language camp, we ask that you arrive promptly 10 am, attend lunch with your group, and stay until the last child in your group has been picked up, usually between 3 and 3:15. We hope that you can find time in your schedule to volunteer a full week for language camp this year.
